Entry Cancellation/Refunds: Office fee is not refundable. Entries with written cancellation on or before the closing date will receive a refund of the class fee. **NO REFUNDS after Closing Date** even if the original Closing date is extended. Entries must be received by 11:59pm on the closing date.

Ride Times: Ride times will be sent by email. Confirm ride times upon checking in at the show office the day of the show.

Membership in WDAAZ is recommended but not required.

- Membership is \$30 per year.

- Non-members will pay a \$30 fee per show/clinic.

Riders who would like to participate in Year-End Awards must be a current member of WDAAZ and WDAA prior to their competition.

***** IMPORTANT *****

Scratches During Show: Competitors are responsible for notifying the Show Manager/Secretary at the Show Office of their intent to scratch a ride prior to the scheduled ride time. Scratches will not be accepted at the competition arena or with the Ring Steward. Scratches are not refundable. All "No Shows" that have not contacted the show office will be considered a scratch for the rest of the show and time slots may be filled.

Arena / Schooling: Competition arenas are 20m X 60m. Competition arenas will be open for hand walking only around the outside of the dressage arena up to one-half hour prior to the start of the first class. Lunging is allowed only in the designated lunging area and not in the warm-up area during the show.

Lunging is allowed only in the designated lunging area and not in the warm-up area during the show. Competition arenas will be open for hand walking only around the outside of the dressage arena up to **30 minutes** prior to the start of the first class.

NOTE: When schooling in the warm-up or competition arena, ALL horses must wear their bridle number when on the show grounds. **Classical riders must wear a helmet.**

Food/Concessions: Free breakfast items and snacks provided near the show office for each paid rider. There will not be a food vendor at the facility, so please plan accordingly.

Riders need to provide their own callers.

PARTICIPANTS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE THEIR SHOW NUMBER VISIBLE ON THEIR HORSE AT ALL TIMES.

Awards: Ribbon to 1st place through 6th place in each Class. Awards will be given to High Point in each division. Ties will be broken by the Collective Marks on the relative test sheet.

Management: Show management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally and/or cancel awards of prizes without claims for damages & change the order of classes, cancel, split, or combine classes at its discretion if deemed necessary.

General Information:

- Dogs must be leashed, quiet, calm and controlled at all times. You must clean up after your dog.
- Horses cannot be ridden by more than two (2) riders. Each rider/horse combination

will require a separate entry fee and entry form.

- Maximum of 4 tests ridden per horse.
- Rules will be governed by the United States Equestrian Federation and WDAA.
- Rules are in force from the moment you enter the grounds.
- Riders are required to clean up after their horses.
- Riders need to provide their own callers.
- Western riding attire is boots, long sleeve shirt, trousers, a Western hat or ATSM (American Society for Testing and Materials) rated helmet.
- It is the rider's responsibility to go to: WDAA Equipment and Attire Guide on their Website: <https://www.westerndressageassociation.org>. One third of the riders will be checked by the Ring Steward AFTER your rides for legal Equipment & Attire.
- Classical Riding Attire is boots (tall or paddock boots with half chaps), breeches, long sleeve shirt, and a ATSM Helmet.
- For the USEF/WDAAZ Release/Waiver, please read it, upload the signed form to Fox Village. If you didn't upload the waiver, please bring it to the show office when you check in.
- Participants are required to clean up after their animals.

The Ring Steward may check for legal equipment and attire AFTER you ride your test (USEF/WD rule WD124).

Coggins Test date and Health Certificate (out-of-state horses) are to be provided at registration.

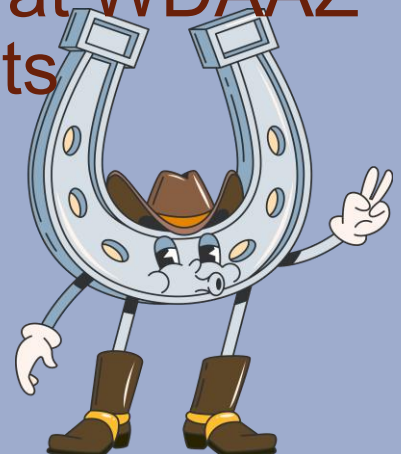

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in the

_____ ("Event") and USEF sanctioned or approved event(s) or activity(ies), including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions, and related or incidental activities related to or in preparation for the Event ("USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any Event and/or USEF Events involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the Event and/or USEF Events organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the Event and/or USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any Event and/or USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at the Event and/or USEF Events.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in the Event and/or USEF Events, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event and/or USEF Events participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event and/or USEF Events owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of the Event and/or USEF Events; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the Event and/or USEF Events; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where the Event and/or USEF Events may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("Liability") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the Event and/or USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

E. COMPLETE AGREEMENT AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: This Agreement represents the complete understanding between the parties regarding these issues and no oral representations, statements or inducements have been made apart from this Agreement. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unlawful, void, or for any reason unenforceable, then that provision shall be deemed severable from this Agreement and shall not affect the validity and enforceability of any remaining provisions.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS DOCUMENT IN ITS ENTIRETY, UNDERSTAND ALL OF ITS TERMS AND CONDITIONS, AND KNOW IT CONTAINS AN ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND WAIVER FROM LIABILITY, AS WELL AS A HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION OBLIGATIONS.

By signing below, I (as the participant or as the Parent/Legal Guardian of the minor identified below) hereby accept and agree to the terms and conditions of this Agreement in connection with my (or the minor's) participation in the Event and/or USEF Events. If, despite this Agreement, I, or anyone on my behalf or the minor's behalf, makes a claim for Liability against any of the Released Parties, I will indemnify, defend and hold harmless each of the Released Parties from any such Liabilities as the result of such claim.

The parties agree that this agreement may be electronically signed. The parties agree that the electronic signatures appearing on this agreement are the same as handwritten signatures for the purposes of validity, enforceability, and admissibility.
